**Do you need specialised aids and equipment and are 16-21 years old?****Do you need mobility assistance equipment or other equipment?**

The **Aids and Equipment Program (A&EP)** may be able to help you access aids, equipment and necessary home modifications (such as rails). Sometimes you also have to make a contribution to the purchase cost. Equipment needs to be prescribed by a therapist; the therapist can also make contact with the A&EP on your behalf.
