

## 2017 EDUCATION Fees Schedule

<p>As a Registered Training Organisation (“RTO”) and Learn Local Provider, MCM offers Accredited, Pre-Accredited and as a non- school senior secondary provider offers VCAL courses.</p> <p>Concessions, fee waivers and exemptions will be considered on a case by case basis. MCM will give each student a <b>Statement of Fees</b> prior to Enrolment.</p> <p><u>Concession fees</u>          Clients that are eligible for concession fees will pay 20% of the full fee. Concessions are available to individuals that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• hold a Health Care Card issued by the Commonwealth (<i>a copy of which <b>must</b> be held by the MCM</i>);</li> <li>• are a dependant spouse or dependent child of a Health Care Card issued by the Commonwealth;</li> <li>• hold a Health Care Card issued by the Commonwealth and are also referred Job Seekers with a standard Job Seeker Referral Form (<i>the RTO must retain a copy of the referral form</i>);</li> <li>• self-identify as being of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent (<i>evidence must be supported on the client enrolment form</i>);</li> <li>• are Single and Teenage parents with an <i>original Single and Teenage Parents Training Initiative Referral Form</i></li> </ul>	<p><u>Fee Waivers/exemptions</u></p> <p>Clients that are eligible for fee waivers/exemptions will not be charged a tuition fee for the course they have chosen to enrol in. Fees waivers/exemptions are available to individuals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• who are from the Judy Lazarus Transition Centre (<i>written confirmation from the management of the Judy Lazarus Transition Centre must be provided to MCM</i>);</li> <li>• who are required to undertake the course pursuant to a community based order made under the Children, Youth and Families Act 2005 (<i>written confirmation from the relevant Youth Justice Unit of the Victorian Department of Human Services must be provided to MCM</i>);</li> <li>• if they are referred to the RTO as a Young People Transitioning From Care (<i>a copy of the relevant Referral Form must be provided to MCM</i>);</li> </ul> <p>For those clients ineligible for fee waivers, MCM will make every effort to access brokerage and/or sponsorships towards covering these fees in particular circumstances.</p> <p>The attached fee structure sets out tuition and materials fees together with the allocated hours of each course.</p>
